Itinerary

Day 1 Adelaide

Step aboard The Ghan in Adelaide for your unforgettable adventure to the Top End. As the train leaves the city heading for the Flinders Ranges and beyond, it's your chance to settle into your cabin and watch the changes in landscape from your private cabin. (lunch, dinner)

Day 2 Alice Springs

After your first night enjoying the fine dining and relaxed luxury of this iconic train, you'll wake to an amazing outback sunrise at Marla – a remote outpost 160kms from the Northern Territory border that marks the start of the Oodnadetta Track. Enjoy more incredible outback scenery, before arriving into Alice Springs early in the afternoon to enjoy an off train excursion that reveals more of this historic outback town. (breakfast, lunch, dinner)

Day 3 Darwin

As you head further north into the tropics, prepare to experience of the Top Ends most impressive natural wonders near Katherine. The stunning Nitmiluk gorge lies within the massive 292,000ha of the Nitmiluk National Park. You'll have the chance to explore it from the water with guided cruise options – an off train excursion. Alternatively, get a glimpse into outback life by visiting a working cattle station with Katherine Outback Experience. A few hours later, you'll arrive in Darwin for a transfer to your accommodation. (breakfast, lunch)

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Day 4 Darwin

Take in the top sights of this tropical city on a morning tour, including the Stokes Hill Wharf area, botanic gardens and the Chinese Temple, the Mooring Basin and the Museum and Art Gallery of the Northern Territory plus Darwin Aviation Museum. This afternoon enjoy a stroll around Darwin, taking in the fascinating history at your own pace. This evening soak up a Darwin sunset whilst you enjoy a Territory style dinner featuring local seafood and produce all while waiting in the comfort of a modern and spacious catamaran (breakfast, dinner)

Day 5 Kakadu

It's time to visit one of the world's most incredible natural environments. As you travel along the Arnhem Highway south east of Darwin the anticipation builds. Soon you'll be in the heart of the world famous Kakadu National Park enjoying a full day of immersive experiences. You'll cruise the Yellow Water Billabong, search for saltwater crocodiles, see a variety of informative displays depicting the rich Aboriginal history of the area of Warradjan Cultural Centre, and be guided to ancient rock art galleries at Nourlangie. (breakfast, lunch)

Day 6 Darwin

At the World Heritage area Ubirr, your guide will reveal extraordinary art sites of spiritual significance to the local Indigenous people dating back more than 20,000 years. On your way to join the Gulyambi Cruise on the East Alligator River, you'll visit a stunning lookout to take in the majestic vistas of the renowned Kakadu wetlands. Later, with special permission of the traditional owners, enjoy the privilege of going ashore in Arnhem Land. To top off an enriching day, you'll visit the Bowali Visitor Centre before returning to Darwin. (lunch)

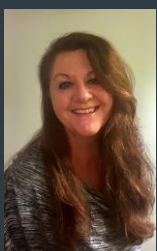
